THAT the Public Meeting to consider a Zoning By-law Amendment be opened at 7:03 p.m. CARRIED

The Manager of Planning & Enforcement explained that the land at Part Lot 11, Concession 1 of the former Township of Matilda, municipally known as 11434 County Road 4/Lakeshore Drive is currently zoned Residential Waterfront (RW) and was subject to a consent application wherein both the severed and retained lot does not conform to the minimum lot area of 3,035 metres squared.

The purpose of this Zoning By-law Amendment is to fulfill one of the Municipal Consent conditions. The Amendment is also needed to change the zoning from Residential Waterfront (RW) to Residential Waterfront Special Exception 14 (RW-14) to reduce the required minimum lot area to 1,850 square metres. It was noted that the advertisement incorrectly stated the zoning would change to a Residential Waterfront Special Exception 12 (RW-12) and should have read Residential Waterfront Special Exception 14 (RW-14) and that no further notice will be given.

The Manager of Planning & Enforcement did not receive any verbal or written queries. The applicants were not present and Council did not have any concerns or objections.
