PUBLIC MEETING (Cont'd)

The Director of Planning & Enforcement explained that the land at the North half Lots 26 and 27, Concession 1, Range 1 of the former Township of Matilda, municipally known as 10546 Broken Second Road is currently zoned Mineral Aggregate-Reserve (MAR) and was subject to a consent application which resulted in the severance of a vacant farm parcel comprising the bulk of the property from a surplus dwelling lot.

The purpose of this Zoning By-law Amendment is to fulfill a condition of approval of the consent application wherein the retained lot is to be rezoned to a residential zone to permit the existing legal non-complying single detached dwelling and accessory structure. The zoning is being changed by rezoning the portion of the retained parcel zoned as Mineral Aggregate-Reserve (MAR) to Rural (RU).

The Director of Planning & Enforcement received no verbal or written concerns from the public. The applicants were present and Council did not have any concerns or objections.
