

Parks & Recreation Master Plan

A Parks & Recreation Master Plan is being prepared for the Municipality of South Dundas to guide and manage the development of facilities, programs and services over the next ten years. The Master Plan will explore:

- Indoor recreation facility needs such as community meeting spaces, arenas and gymnasiums.
- Outdoor recreation facility needs such as sports fields, hard surface courts, playgrounds, splash pads and special event spaces.
- Parks, open spaces, waterfront and trails.
- Service delivery, including policies and programs.

Population Growth

The population is projected to grow to 11,700 residents by 2031. Most of the growth is expected to occur in Morrisburg, which currently makes up approximately 22% of the Municipality's total population.


\$65,067 was the median household income in 2015. 14% of residents were experiencing low-income.



Age Groups

Between 2011 and 2016, the population of children, adults, older adults and seniors increased. The population of youth and mature adults decreased.









Key Trends to Consider

Facility Trends

- Recreation facilities are aging, requiring municipalities to reinvest, replace or repurpose infrastructure.
- Accessibility legislation requires that new / renovated municipal facilities accommodate persons with disabilities.
- Modern municipal facilities serve as community hubs and, where possible, are multi-use in design to provide a variety of civic programs and services for all residents.

Participation Trends

- Physical activity levels have remained low for a number of years due to a lack of free time and other related factors.
- Unstructured and self-scheduled activities are growing in popularity.
- There are increasing requests for emerging activities such as pickleball and outdoor fitness equipment.

Parks and Trail Trends

- Parks are being recognized for their environmental role in improving air quality, mitigating flooding from extreme weather, and reducing the urban heat island effect.
- A connected trail system offers personal health and wellness benefits by promoting outdoor physical activities.

Service Delivery Trends

- Partnerships between municipalities and community organizations enhance efficiencies.
- Community development models support community organizations to deliver programs and services.

COVID-19 Trends

- Increased usage of parks and trails.
- Impact on programs and organizations.
