## HOW TO LOAD AT HOME BEFORE USING THE LANDFILL

To keep money in your pocket and save time, have your load already separated prior to coming to the Landfill. This makes it easier for scale house attendant to properly charge the items and reduce the amount of Landfill space used. Better visual separation means the customer will save money, and valuable Landfill space by diverting these items to they're designated areas.

## DUMP TRAILERS

All dump trailers will be asked to back off the gravel pad completely. Refusal to back off the gravel pad will result in the customer unloading the entire load by hand to ensure the load is in the designated tipping area.

- Always ensure you are properly hitched. (Proper ball to trailer tongue.)
- Check your battery to make sure it is fully charged. (Or bring battery pack.)
- Check your hydraulic fluid reservoir to ensure it is full of fluid.
- Avoid standing between trailer and vehicle in case it unhooks during dumping.
- Check to ensure you have the means to keep your doors tied up when dumping.
- Remove tarp so contents of load do not rip or tear tarp.

Customers with dump trailers will need to stop at scale house to have load inspected and bill started, however, payment of load will be required after load has been dumped and confirmed by hill attendant of separation or non-separation.

## WOOD LOADS

If you know you are going to have multiple loads, book the day to deliver these loads to the landfill for only \$10.00 for the day. Done properly, an entire tree can be brought into the site for a minimal cost. To keep your bill lower when it comes to wood, here are your options:
