

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH DUNDAS

BY-LAW NO. 2021-05

A By-law to authorize the closure of specified sidewalks on a seasonal basis.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides that the powers of the municipality shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, authorizes a municipality to pass a by-law to permanently close a highway or part of a highway.

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 239/02 defines a "sidewalk" as the part of the highway specifically set aside or commonly understood to be for pedestrian use, typically consisting of a paved surface but does not include crosswalks, medians, boulevards, shoulders or any part of the sidewalk where cleared snow has been deposited;

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 239/02 states that when a municipality closes a highway or part of a highway pursuant to its powers under the Act, the highway is deemed to be in a state of repair in respect of all conditions described in Ontario Regulation 239/02 from the time of the closure until the highway is re-opened by the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of South Dundas deems it expedient to authorize the seasonal closure of specified sidewalks.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of South Dundas enacts as follows:

1. That all sidewalks, save and except the sidewalks identified in Schedule "A", as attached, and forming part of this By-law, shall be closed on November 1 and reopened on April 1 of the following year.
2. That any By-law inconsistent with this By-law is hereby repealed.
3. And that this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of its passing.

- Fifth Street West from St. Lawrence Street to Ottawa Street (north side)
