

South Dundas Waterfront Dog Park

Please be advised that users of the dog park do so at their own risk.

Before you enter, please be sure to read and understand the following rules:

1. Dog owners/handlers are legally and financially responsible for the actions of their dogs. All owners will be responsible for their dog's behaviour under the Province of Ontario Dog Owners Liability Act (DOLA).

2. Dogs must be licensed, vaccinated, and wearing current tags.

Proof of core vaccinations and license is required upon request of an animal control officer who will be making periodic visits to the park.

Tags may serve as proof.

3. Dogs in heat or coming into heat are prohibited from entering the park.

4. Dogs must be at least 4 months old to use the park.

5. For the safety of your dog(s) and other park visitors, choke, prong(pinch) and spike collars are strictly prohibited.

If you use any of these collars, you must remove them before entering the park.

6. No dogs weighing greater than 30lbs are allowed in the small dog area.

- 7. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the park.
- **8.** Owners must remain in the park with their dog(s) and carry a leash.
- **9.** A handler may bring no more than two dogs into the park.
- **10.** Dogs must be under voice control of the handler.
- **11.** Owners are required to pick up and dispose of all waste left by their dogs.
- **12.** A handler is required to fill any hole the dog digs.
- **13.** Dogs must be removed at the first sign of aggression.
- **14.** Dogs that are barking excessively must be removed from the park.
- **15.** No glass containers are allowed in the park.
- **16.** Children 12 and under must be closely supervised by an adult.

17. No pit bull or pit bull crosses are allowed in the park, as stated in the Dog Owners Liability Act (DOLA).

Failure to comply with park rules may result in loss of privileges and owners may be ticketed. Enjoy the park with your dog and help keep it clean! Please note: The park may be closed at times for special events or maintenance.
