BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Municipality of South Dundas Council recognize May as Huntington's Disease Awareness Month.

WHEREAS, Huntington's disease is a fatal genetic disorder that causes the progressive breakdown of nerve cells in the brain, deteriorating a person's physical and mental abilities during their prime working years; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no effective treatment or cure for Huntington's disease, but the dedicated work of researchers, medical professionals, and advocacy organizations continues to bring hope for breakthrough therapies; and

WHEREAS, the Huntington Society of Canada is the premier nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the lives of everyone affected by Huntington's disease through community services, education, advocacy, and research; and
