D) Picnic tables – David will contact SDHS about building them and using the South Dundas logo on them as well. We are hoping to put more tables at the splash pad and at the dock.

Garden around compass - Cindy will contact the Horticultural Society to see if they are interested in this. Approx \$2000 can be used to do this.

The Christmas lights were a hit with residents. It would be nice to have hydro available to the lights along the walkway. David will check on a price for this. Possibly every other pole.

E) Grants – OPG still waiting. Nancy will reach out to South Nation Conservation to apply for money for plants.

G) Cigarette Receptacles – According to local Bylaw, smoking is not permitted in the parks or dock area. Signs indicating this will be installed and the cigarette receptacles will be removed from the pavilion at the dock.
