a. Amphitheatre Review & Updates:

b. Earl Baker Park Multi-Use Pad Fundraising Working Group:

Next meeting for the group is April 20th, 2026. \$696 was raised for the Earl Baker Park Recreation Fund at the Great Williamsburg Egg Hunt.

Municipal Staff held interviews for the 2-part time By-law officer Position. Will have an updated start date on those new positions at the next meeting.

Committee raised concerns about the Provincial Governments announcement about the new alcohol in parks initiative. Municipal Staff to review proposed legislation and bring update to next meeting.

Committee went over the draft Park Rules sign and provided comments and feedback.

d. Projects/Budget (\$20,000):

- **Crosswalk:** Go ahead has been given to the painters. Start date TBD.
- **Movies/Events:** June 27 will be the double feature movie night at the Cruickshank Amphitheatre. Naru's Sound will once again be doing the movies. It is hoped to have a second movie on July 25th, using Anglican church's equipment.

a) Dog waste receptacles

Bike rack at waterfront needs a more visible location. Municipal Staff will see

In 2024 the Committee had discussed erecting a welcome sign at the corner of Ottawa St and Cruickshank Way. Municipal Staff will touch base with the Community Development and Communications Coordinator.
