Brinston Municipal Drain

Dear Property Owner;

Please be advised that assessed costs for maintenance/repair costs on the Brinston Municipal Drain, which was completed in 2024, have been added to the "Special Charges" section of the 2026 Final Tax Bill.

A map has been provided to illustrate the location of the drain and watershed area. The names shown on the map are from 1977. While the municipality keeps an updated record of current ownership, the map cannot be changed without engaging the services of a drainage engineer.

Costs are assessed based on the engineer's report, adopted by council under By-Law No. 78-39. A copy of the report can be provided if requested.

If you have any questions or concerns pertaining to the engineer's report watershed limits, please contact the municipal office in Morrisburg.
